Solar Energy Rebate

Navarro supports interconnected co-generation with net metering, per the terms of our tariff. With our Energy Efficiency Rebate Program, we now offer a \$1000 rebate on solar generation systems larger than 1,000 watts installed at total electric residential locations. A pre- and post-inspection must be performed by Navarro on all installations. Please contact energyaudits@navarroec.com for more information on this program.

Heat Pump Rebate

Members who replace existing HVAC equipment (in electric-only, single family homes) are eligible to receive a \$150 rebate for a 14 SEER High Efficiency Heat Pump and a \$300 rebate for a 15 SEER High Efficiency Heat Pump (or higher). The incentive rebates for this program apply for replacement of existing HVAC equipment at any residential home and new home construction. The member must provide a copy of the receipt with the Air-Conditioning Heating and Refrigeration Institute ("ARI") designation of the qualifying

installation from the installing contractor for verification purposes. This incentive rebate is not applicable for homes that use natural gas for heating.

HVAC Tune-Up

Residential members who have an energy audit performed on their single family homes are eligible to receive up to a \$100 rebate on an HVAC tune-up performed by a qualified service professional. An annual HVAC tune up includes: checking and correcting the unit's refrigerant pressure and tubing, checking and adjusting belt tension, cleaning and lubricating the indoor blower unit, replacing filters, cleaning inside the "A" coil, and checking the thermostat, wiring, and other electric parts. A copy of the receipt from a qualified contractor stating that the work above was completed must be provided to Navarro. You may request an energy audit at energyaudits@navarroec.com to take advantage of this rebate.
